

# **Self-Referral**

## **Information Leaflet**

Thank you for your interest in using our centre.

Families seeking to use our centres on a self-referral basis are required to go through the following process.

#### Attend pre visit interviews.

There will be separate interviews for resident and non resident parents. They will be used to gather information about both parents and the children and a brief history as to why they need to use our service. We will also take this opportunity to discuss your expectations and to provide information about the centre.

We would also need you to give permission to contact the Northern Health and Social Care Trust to assist us in assessing any risks.

A copy of this information leaflet has been sent to both parties. Contact cannot take place unless both parties agree and sign up to our consent of use policy (copy attached).

#### **Length and duration of Contact**

We have three centres and their opening times are as follows;

Ballymena Saturday 10.00am – 12.00pm (weekly)

Antrim Saturday 11.00am - 1.00pm (fortnightly)

Larne Saturday 10.00am- 12.00pm (fortnightly)

**Use of Contact Centres is not a long term solution to contact.** It is important that both parents use this time to address the issue of a more permanent arrangement for contact.
